

Notation

 $\ddagger \sharp d d$ Quarter tone sharp, three-quarter tones sharp, quarter tone flat, three-quarter tones flat.

Eighth tone sharp, quarter tone + eighth tone sharp, semitone + eighth tone sharp, quarter tone + eighth tone flat, eighth tone flat.

Crescendo from nothing/decrescendo to nothing.

T tr Timbral trill.

smz (\$)_-__ Smorzato. Rhythmic vibrato using jaw or diaphragm. Perform until dotted line ends.

Gradually transition from previous technique to the next.

Flutter tongue.


Slap tongue.

Open slap tongue: with tongue pressed against the reed, abruptly open embouchure, producing a short, explosive, percussive attack.

Key clicks. Specific pitches, although notated, are not expected to be produced.

- After the slap tongue in m. 23, perform random key clicks progressing from very fast and gradually becoming slower.
- -Diamond shaped note-heads are air sounds. Text inside brackets are phonemes to be performed as air sounds; for example [s] above the staff indicates to voice "s" as in "sun" through the instrument.
